

Short course on the Bible offered at ACU Adelaide

Prominent theology scholar Rev Dr Michael Trainor will present a series of public lectures on the Bible at Australian Catholic University (ACU) Adelaide Campus from Wednesday 8 August.

The short course, 'The Bible for living' has been designed to help the general public learn to engage with the Bible in a more theologically informed way.

The short course reflects the important role the ACU Adelaide Campus plays in delivering theological education to the public in South Australia.

Senior Lecturer in Biblical Studies at ACU Rev Dr Trainor said the course was aimed at people who find the Bible a challenging book but would like to have an accessible introduction to it and in a way that nourishes faith.

"Most people in our church have a great passion for learning and a desire to deepen their appreciation of the Catholic Faith," Rev Dr Trainor said.

"The course is one small step to deepen participants' biblical literacy and spirituality. In fact, it will be life changing,"

"Each session of the course will have two parts.

"The first will introduce the major forms of writing in the Bible including the story of creation in *Genesis*, the call of Moses in *Exodus*, the *Psalms*, some of the writings of St Paul and the gospel of Luke. The second will offer ways these pieces of Scripture can nourish the spiritual life of the contemporary searcher."
