Southern Cross Catholic College has joined the ranks of Ryan Catholic College and St Anthony's Catholic College and is now able to offer families with a smooth transition from Prep to Year 12. The College will welcome its first cohort of Year 12 students when school commences next week.

In 2013, the primary school announced their plans to expand to secondary. The college began with Years 7 and 8 in 2015 and additional secondary levels were added each year until 2019 when the full Prep to Year 12 project was complete.
