



EREA Launches Child Safeguarding Standards Framework

Edmund Rice Education Australia (EREA) launched their new Child Safeguarding Standards Framework today. It is significant that the Framework is being launched at the start of **National Child Protection Week** and reaffirms EREA's commitment to creating an environment where the safety, wellbeing and participation of all children and young people is paramount.

Dr Wayne Tinsey, EREA Executive Director, said that the Framework "is designed to further enhance a culture within each of our schools wherein protecting children and young people from abuse and other harm, and the promotion of child safety, participation, empowerment and wellbeing is embedded in the everyday thinking and practice of leaders, staff and volunteers."

The purpose and intent of the Standards contained in the Framework is to embed a culture of child safety and wellbeing by demonstrating values in practice; nurturing the wellbeing of all children and young people, respecting their dignity, ensuring their safety and protecting them from abuse and other harm.
