## Lead Facilitator, Mercy Leadership Program and Dublin Pilgrimage Expression of Interest

The Mercy Leadership Program and Dublin Pilgrimage provides a life-changing and life-giving experience for those in governance and executive leadership roles in the Mercy Ministry Companions group of ministries. Through attendance at a three-module program, participants have opportunities to deepen their understanding of the Mercy charism, including completing a program at Mercy International Centre in Dublin.

We seek to recruit a person who can lead the program into the future. A deep knowledge of the Mercy charism, high-level group facilitation skills and experience in delivering adult formation programs are among the qualities and expertise we are seeking.

The Lead Facilitator role is not full-time. The role has some peak periods when in-person modules of the program are being delivered, along with extended periods with a lower work volume when planning, preparation and review are being undertaken.

The appointee may be an external facilitator, engaged on a contract basis. Alternatively, they may already be employed in a ministry in the MMC group, probably in a role that entails delivery of formation experiences. It is envisaged that if the appointee is internal, they will retain their substantive role at their ministry and be released (with internal replacement as needed) to undertake the duties of this role. If an internal appointment is made, negotiations will be held with the ministry involved to ensure the requirements of this role can be met without jeopardizing their ministry role.
