Having previously worked for the Church in Sydney, Cormac served as Liaison and Research Officer, and Secretary for the Vocations ministry.

He holds a Master of Philosophy and Bachelor of Arts from the University of Notre Dame Australia.

Cormac is married and has five energetic young boys. He serves at his local parish of St Finbar's in the lower Blue Mountains directing a choir and is a volunteer firefighter.
