One year of supporting earthquake-affected communities in Syria

6 February marks one year since the devastating earthquakes shook Syria and Turkey, claiming the lives of thousands, and causing more destruction and trauma to millions more Syrians who were already surviving 12 long years of conflict.

In response to this emergency, Jesuit Mission Australia launched a Syrian Earthquake Response Appeal to provide immediate assistance to those people most affected living in Aleppo, where the Jesuits were already actively supporting refugees.

Thanks to the generosity of the Australian Catholic community, in one year, over 44,000 women, men and children have been provided with emergency assistance, including food, warm clothing, shelter, healthcare and vital psychosocial support. This life-giving response is being delivered by Jesuit Refugee Service (JRS) Syria in partnership with Jesuit Mission Australia and the Xavier Network.

"A crisis will shake the foundations of any communities, but compassion and solidarity have the power to rebuild them," said Helen Forde, CEO of Jesuit Mission Australia.

"We are so grateful for the heartfelt generosity of our Jesuit Mission family as Syria's vulnerable population face more trauma and terror."

Amidst the somber reflection on the one-year anniversary of the devastating earthquakes in Syria and Turkey, Jesuit Mission remains steadfast in its commitment to rebuilding shattered lives.

Using the funding already raised, the Jesuits are committed to continue the program of emergency support activities into 2024 that will help the long-term recovery of women, children and men affected by the earthquake and conflict.

"Thank you to those who supported our Earthquake appeal, your generosity continues to restore hope and empower resilience," said Ms Forde.
