



Catholic School Parents Queensland welcomes additional \$100,000 funding to support families

Catholic School Parents Queensland (CSPQ) has welcomed the announcement of an additional \$100,000 funding from the Queensland government to enhance their work with families in Catholic Schools.

CSPQ Executive Director, Carmel Nash said 'These funds will assist CSPQ to further develop our work and to build resources to assist schools to engage families in their children and young people's learning and wellbeing.'

CSPQ will work with Catholic education authorities across Queensland to develop curriculum connected resources so that families can build their capacity to support learning at home particularly in the areas of literacy and numeracy across P - 10.

Research shows that when families and schools work together to support learning not only does learning improve but behaviour improves, young people stay at school longer, teachers are happier and families stay connected.

This funding will go a long way to supporting authentic partnerships between home and school.

CSPQ is the peak body for the families of the over 160,000 students in 312 Catholic schools in Queensland.
