Father Ihor speaks candidly about the realities of the war and provides insights often lacking from Western media. He discusses Ukraine's historical experiences with diplomacy, the dangers of political fatigue among Western allies, and the profound impact of the war on the nation's spiritual life.

The conversation also addresses the shifting political landscape, including statements from former U.S. President Donald Trump questioning the long-term financial commitment to Ukraine's defence. Father Ihor expresses concern that such rhetoric prioritises economic interests over the moral imperative of supporting a nation under siege. "This does not sound like prioritising a just peace," he states. "It sounds like prioritising cost-saving."

Despite the challenges, he remains steadfast in his belief that the fight for Ukraine is a fight for justice. "People think that hope is something for the weak," he says. "But we see now, in the people fighting on the front lines, that hope is for the strong ones. Maybe that is why Christ gives hope."
